## Lesson 4: Personal Pronouns

## Personal Pronouns [viwakilishi - nafsi]

There are three personal pronouns in Swahili:

- A). First person pronoun
- B). Second person pronoun
- C). Third person pronoun

Each personal pronoun has a singular and a plural form.

A). First Person Pro	noun

C). Third Person Pronoun	
<u>Umoja [singular]</u> <b>Yeye</b> [He/She, Her/Him] Represented by <b>A</b> - <u>Wingi [plural]</u> <b>Wao</b> [They/Them] Represented by <b>WA</b> -

**5. Mimi ninaitwa John.** [I am called John]

Na wewe je? [And what about you?]

Mimi <u>**ni**</u>naitwa Andrew. [I am called Andrew.]
